Remember, classes are 6 of 8 Saturdays, and only 2 hours of your 7 hours on the mountain but it remains the centerpiece of our program. So, thoughtfully (and realistically) assess your skills as a snowboarder or skier then carefully complete both CK and Stevens Pass registration forms.

Participants must have a certified snow-sport helmet, and are strongly encouraged to wear them while riding.

Learn To Ski/Ride

Class #101– first time skier/rider

Class#201–skied or snowboarded before. For example, ridden chair 2 to 3 times

Intermediate Ski/Ride

Class #301—green terrain skiers and riders ready to explore blue terrain

Class # 401—blue terrain skiers and riders ready to explore black terrain

Advanced Ski/Ride

Course # 501—skiers and riders that are already on black terrain and want to explore the whole mountain

Expert level courses

Progression Sessions - freestyle & park instruction with a competition focus ~ helmets required

Instructor Academy - learning to teach skiing/riding for possible future employment at the mountain

Backcountry Basics - Finding the stashes, reading the conditions, knowing the mountain like a pro
